Members Seeking Sustainerhood

Who is eligible to become a Sustainer?

- A member who has completed a minimum of ten (10) active years of service. Years in which a member took a Leave of Absence do not count as active years of service. A member's Provisional year does not count as a year of active service.
- A member who has reached age 40, joined the JLP after the 2006-2007 League year, and has a minimum of five (5) active years of service, not counting years in which she took a Leave of Absence or her Provisional year.
- A member who has reached age 40, joined the JLP prior to the 2007-2008 League year, and has served a minimum of three (3) active years, not counting years in which she took a Leave of Absence or her Provisional year.
