The New Member Program runs from September 2016 through April 2017, during which New Members, organized into small groups supported by a New Member Advisor, are engaged in the League's service to the community at the same time as learning about the organization itself. In April, those New Members who have successfully completed all requirements are invited to join the League as Active Members.
